GREATER ROCHESTER REGION – PROFILE OF SENIORS

The Rochester Area Community Foundation, which is assessing civic engagement opportunities and constraints for older citizens in the six-county Rochester region, contracted with CGR to develop a demographic profile of the region's seniors.

Our analysis focuses on the 60+ population. We include targeted information on the next younger age group – where possible, the 50-59 age group.

Our data sources are Census 2000; Census 2006 estimates made available in March 2007; Claritas, Inc., a provider of demographic data; and Census 2000 Public Use Microdata Sample (PUMS).

60+ Population Our key findings for the 60+ population in Genesee, Livingston, Monroe, Ontario, Orleans and Wayne counties:

* The age group as a percentage of the region's total population:

- ♦ 16.6% in 2000
- ♦ 18.5% ¹ in 2006
- ◆ 21.2% in 2011
- Total numbers in the region for the age group are projected to rise between 2000 and 2011 by 45,070 – nearly 25%. Data show:
 - ♦ 183,023 2000
 - ◆ 200,878 2006
 - ◆ 228,093 2011

¹ Throughout this report, 2006 data are estimates from either the Census or Claritas, and all 2011 projections are based on Claritas estimates.



- Growth in the age group measured as a percentage of the total population – is outstripping comparable growth in the nation.
 - 2000 16.6% of total region vs. 16.3% total US
 - ◆ 2006 18.5% of total region vs. 17.1% total US
 - ◆ 2011 21.2% of total region vs. 19.1% total US
- ◆ The percent change in region total population for the age group:
 - ◆ 2000-2006 9.8%
 - ◆ 2006-2011 12.6%
- By 2011, Orleans is projected to have the highest proportion of 60+ residents among the six counties (24%), followed by Ontario and Genesee (each nearly 22%)
- Total numbers for the region by race/ethnicity:
 - White: 169,571 (2000); 183,983 (2006); 205,950 (2011)
 - Black:: 9,748 (2000); 11,974 (2006); 14,153 (2011)
 - Hispanic: 2,628 (2000); 3,870 (2006); 4,580 (2011)

 - ◆ 11.6% in 2000
 - ♦ 13.7% in 2006

 - ♦ 127,489 2000
 - ♦ 149,696 2006
 - ♦ 161,874 2011



- Growth in the age group measured as a percentage of the total population is outstripping comparable growth in the nation.
 - ◆ 2000 11.6% of total region vs. 11.0% total US
 - ◆ 2006 13.7% of total region vs. 12.6% total US
 - ◆ 2011 14.8% of total region vs. 13.7% total US
- By 2011 more than one third (36%) of the region's population is projected to be age 50 or older.

Transportation Access, 55-59 & 60+ in 2000 Census 2000 PUMS information combines the 6-county region with Wyoming County. For this 7-county region, the Census estimates are:

- \diamond 60+ residents without access to vehicles 19,602
- ✤ 55-59 residents without access to vehicles 3,103

Census 2000 PUMS information is provided for Monroe County, excluding Webster. For Monroe County minus Webster, the Census estimates are:

• 60+ residents without access to vehicles – 13,888

✤ 55-59 residents without access to vehicles – 2,401

 55+ residents in 6-county region below poverty level – 16,145, and of this total 9,752 were age 65+
