
Oversight Requirements & Prescriptive Authority by State



Note: Oversight/Authority to prescribe refers to an NPs ability to practice independently, or whether a physician's supervision or collaboration is required. Collaboration definitions vary by state and frequently include a requirement for written practice protocols. In general, legal scopes of practice for NPs vary considerably at the state level.
